Erratum: Haruka Inoue et al., “Fundamental Study on Detection of Dangerous Objects on the Road Surface Leading to Motorcycle Accidents Using a 360-Degree Camera”

In the article “Fundamental Study on Detection of Dangerous Objects on the Road Surface Leading to Motorcycle Accidents Using a 360-Degree Camera,” by Haruka Inoue and Yuma Nakasuji, which was published on March 26, 2025, the video resolution given in Section 3.2 on page 3 was incorrect. “The video resolution is 1,920 x 960 for both.” should instead appear as “The video resolution is full HD for both.” Also, the video resolutions given in Section 3.3 on page 4 were incorrect. “In Experiment 2, the dangerous object detection method is applied to the video images shot using THETA V with resolutions of 1,920 x 960 and 2,840 x 1,920 to verify its versatility for different resolutions. It should be noted that as THETA SC only has a resolution of 1,920 x 960, it was excluded from the experiment.” should instead appear as “In Experiment 2, the dangerous object detection method is applied to the video images shot using THETA V with resolutions of full HD and 4K to verify its versatility for different resolutions. It should be noted that as THETA SC only has a resolution of full HD, it was excluded from the experiment.” and “4k” should instead appear as “4K”. The online version has been corrected.
